- Enrollment of 2,288
- Graduate academic medical center in Fort Worth's cultural district
- Since 2002, *U.S. News and World Report* has called UNTHSC's Texas College of Osteopathic Medicine one of the nation's top 50 medical primary care schools
- Research funding: \$47 million/year
- Areas of strength include Primary Care, Alzheimer's research, eye diseases, forensic genetics, interprofessional education

UNT Dallas



- Enrollment has increased 40% in just two years to a record 3,513 students
- Diverse student population is 40% Hispanic and 35% African American
- Community-focused university engages with local neighborhoods, police, schools and policy-makers
- Innovative school of education is focused on developing a bilingual teacher pipeline to fulfill a shortage of qualified candidates in DFW area schools
- Located in Downtown Dallas, UNT Dallas College of Law graduated its first class and earned provisional accreditation from the American Bar Association in 2017

Over the past 15 years, the UNT System has added a new university, engineering school, pharmacy school, law school, a developing MD school and nearly 4 million square feet of classroom, research and residential space in order to meet the needs of its growing region.

EDUCATED POPULATION AND MORE CREDENTIALS: System-wide enrollment at all-time high of 43,922 for Fall 2017 semester.

COMPLETION: UNT's 6-Year graduation rate rose from 36% to 58% in the last 15 years, and, system-wide, the number of degrees awarded annually nearly doubled.

MARKETABLE SKILLS: All UNTS institutions include goals for students to gain career-related experience as part of their strategic plans. UNT's "Career Connect" program is designed to help students develop and identify marketable job skills.

DEBT: The average student loan debt at both UNT and UNT Dallas is less than \$22,000, and UNT Dallas ranked No. 2 nationally for lowest student debt among public universities in a study using Peterson's College Data.
