## Low-Producing Program Review

In order for a degree program to be identified as lowproducing, the number of its graduates is, over a cumulative five-year period:

Fewer than 25 graduates for undergraduate programs;
Fewer than 15 graduates for master's programs; and
Fewer than 10 graduates for doctoral programs.

Staff may recommend to an institution's governing board the closure of a program, if it has been LPP for three or more consecutive reviews (TAC Rule 4.290).
