Out-of-State Enrollment Patterns of Texas Public High School Graduates
























The 60x30TX completion goal includes a target of increasing the enrollment percentage of Texas public high school graduates into Texas colleges directly from high school.

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Key take-aways from NSC data

Through a partnership, THECB was able to obtain National Student Clearinghouse data which showed:

- 10% direct from high school graduates attend college out-of-state and 90% of those students attend a four-year institution
- Economically disadvantaged and Hispanic students are less likely to leave the state than White and African American students
- The states and institutions with the most enrollments from Texas are generally those that are contiguous or have the largest populations



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
