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Preliminary Headcount Data

- Preliminary enrollment information is collected as of the 12th class day
- Data are certified for all institutions in December; final certified data will be available in early 2020
- Headcount includes total enrollment at all public and independent, not-for-profit, institutions
- Traditionally, certified headcounts were lower than preliminary counts; last fall certified counts were about the same as the preliminary numbers


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
Preliminary enrollments grew less than one percent. Health-related institutions gained the most; Independent colleges show a slight decrease
