


Evolution

• 2012	Counselor Suite adds FAFSA data
• 2015	FAFSA Agreements with US DOE and ISDs


Who can access what... Security


Applications: Creation to Institutions



NSC = National Student Clearinghouse




FAFSA: USDOE to Counselor Suite
