<u>Consideration of adopting the Commissioner's recommendation to the Board relating to the certification of Texas Research Incentive Program gift funds to the Emerging Research Universities</u>

RECOMMENDATION: Approval

Background Information:

The 81st Texas Legislature created the Texas Research Incentive Program (TRIP), establishing a research matching fund for the emerging research universities.

The legislation requires the Board to certify that the gifts or endowments received by each emerging research university were donated for the purpose of enhancing research activities at the institution, such as endowed chairs, professorships, research facilities, research equipment, program costs, or graduate research stipends or fellowships. Once the gifts are certified, the percentage matched is statutorily mandated leaving no discretion in the amount of matching funds that the institutions receive, subject to the amount appropriated.

The amounts are being certified so the Legislature will have a basis for determining the amounts to appropriate for the 2018-19 biennium. At the time of the printing these agenda materials, the amount eligible for certification by institution was still being determined. Supplemental materials will be sent under separate cover. After the Governor signs the appropriations bill for the 2018-19 biennium, the Board will approve the distribution of the state match among institutions.
