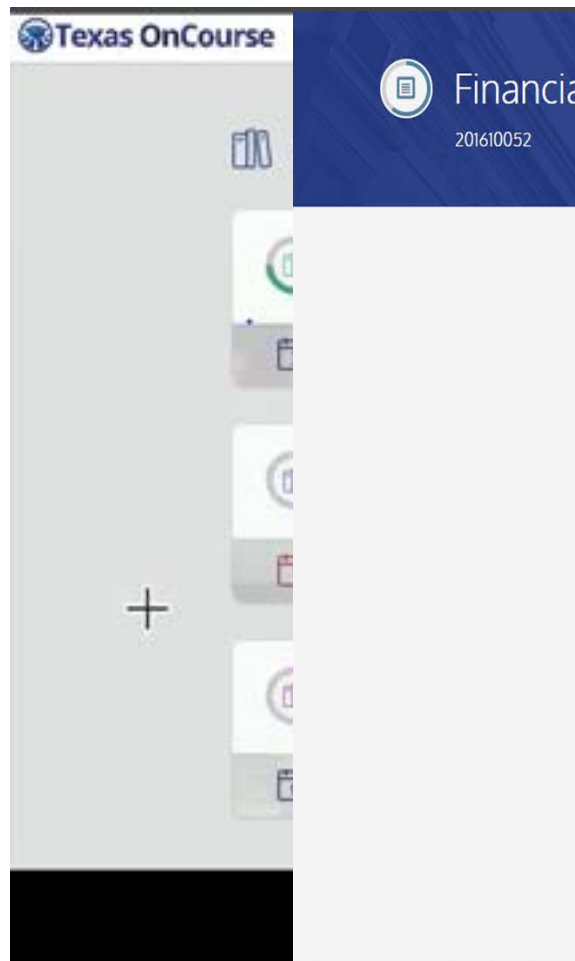

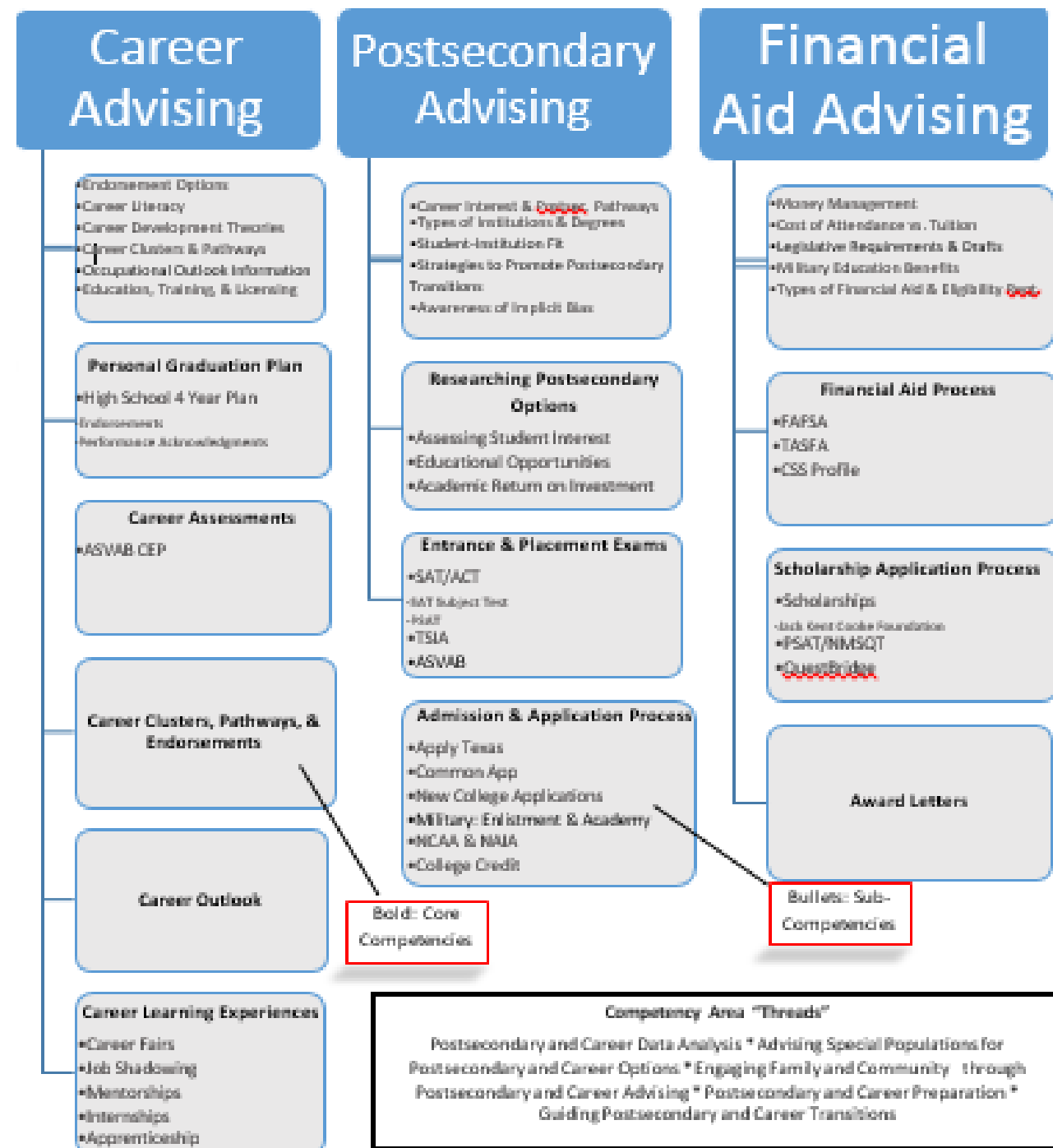
Whose Parental Information to Report on the FAFSA

Click on each of the headings below to learn more about these topics.

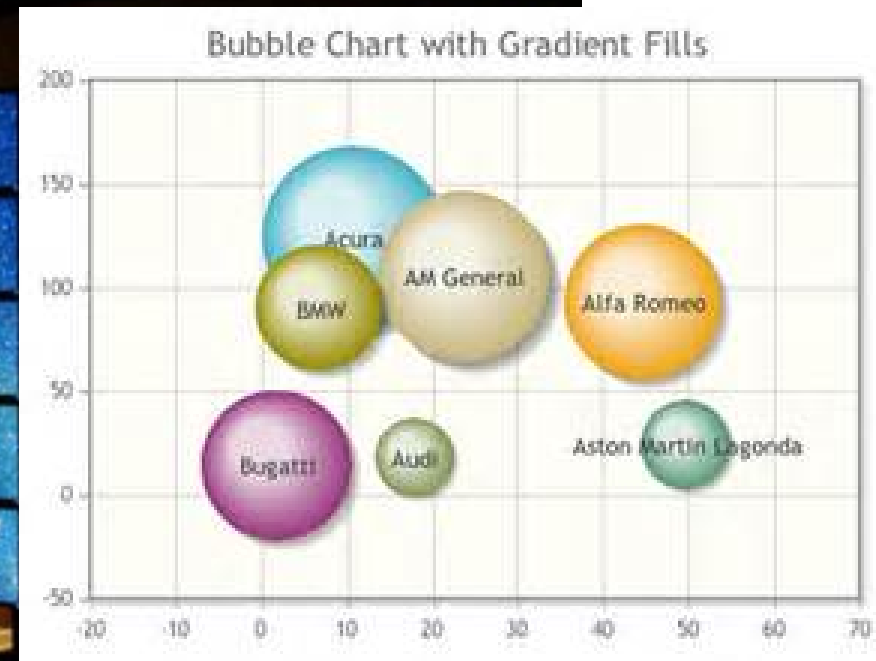
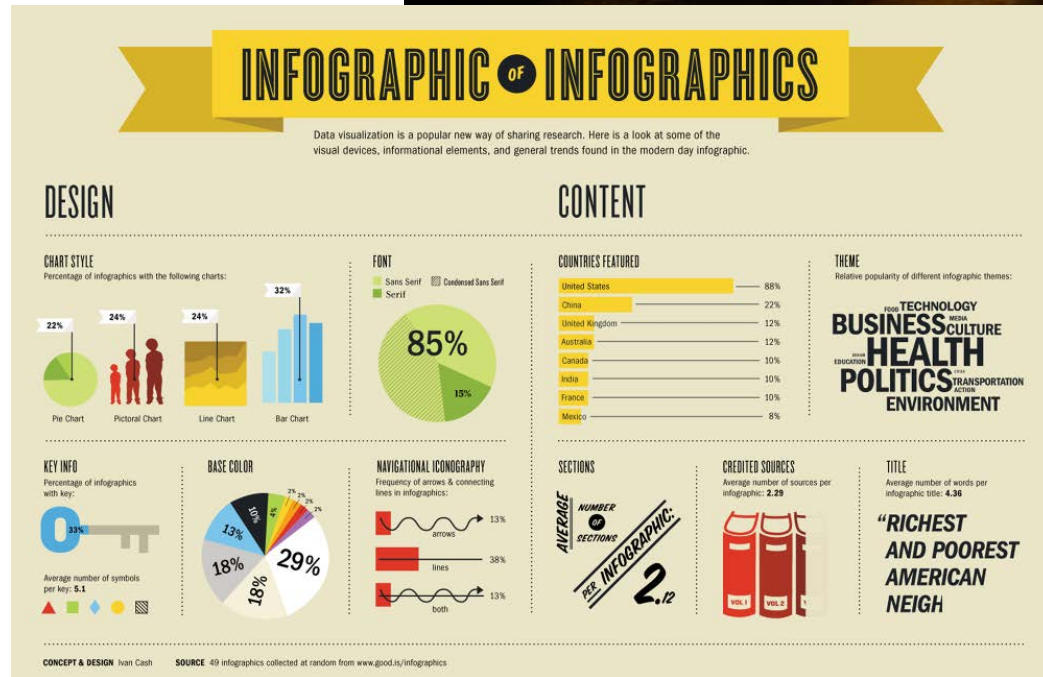
Parental situation	Whose information to report
The student's parents are living and legally married to each other.	The parent whom the student lived with more during past 12 months (if time is the same, the parent who provided more financial support to the student) 
The student's parents are living together and are not married.	
The student's parent is widowed or was never married.	
The student's parents are divorced or separated and don't live together. >	
The student's parents are divorced but live together.	
The student's parents are separated but live together. (Marital status is "married" or "remarried.")	
The student has a parent who is married to the legal parent.

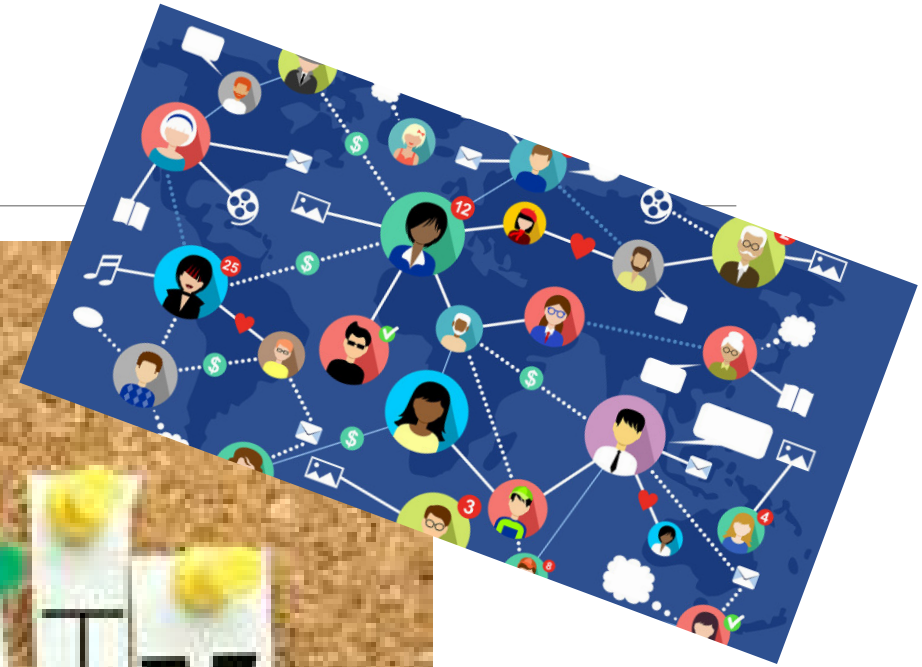
