- \* Academic support personnel to assist the implementation of Pathways Initiatives.

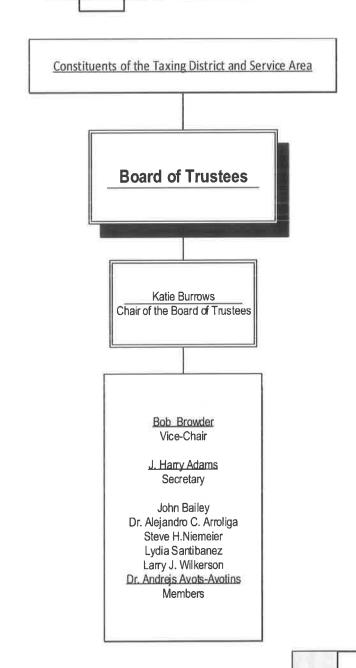
