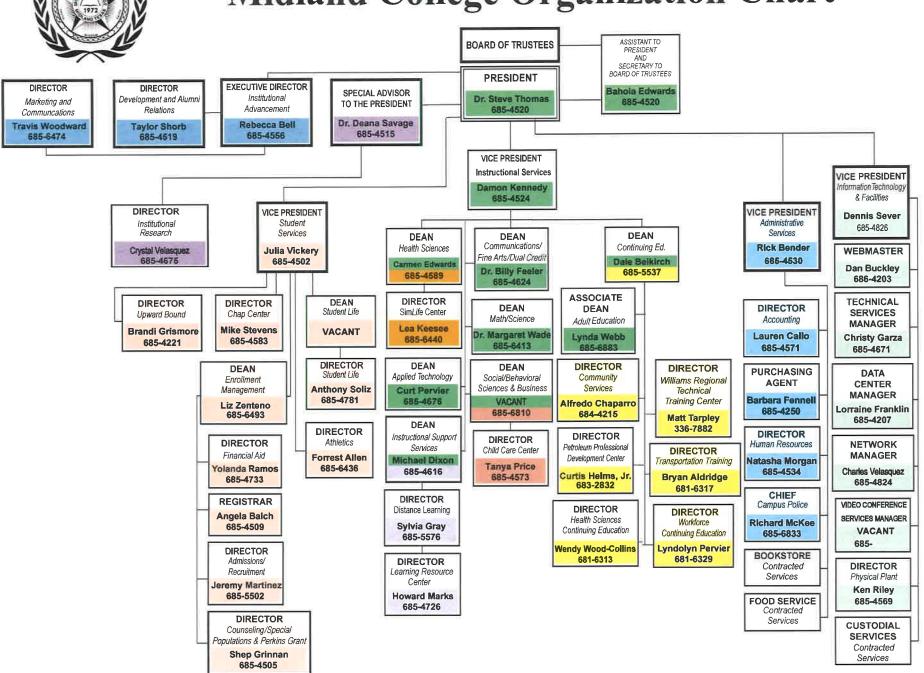

#### 995 Midland College

Community colleges have never been more important. From their original mission of serving the needs of returning service members, community colleges now have a greatly expanded mission to prepare students to compete successfully in the 21st-century knowledge based economy. Midland College, along with the other Texas community college districts educate the workforce of the future – registered nurses; solar and wind power experts; IT technicians; displaced workers in need of retraining and new careers; welders; and auto and diesel mechanics.

Community colleges now educate more than half of all undergraduate college students including first-generation to college students. No other system of higher education does so much to provide access, mentoring and second-chance opportunities as community colleges.

Midland College District respectfully supports the \$1.9 billion formula funding request submitted by the Texas Association of Community Colleges (TACC) on behalf of all Texas community colleges in its letter dated July 24, 2018. Funding of the community college formulas is critical if the state is to meet the goals set forth in the 60X30XTX plan.
