Dear Regents:

System office budget initiatives for Fiscal Year 2014 include funding of employee salary increases, on-going marketing and communications projects and the recently-implemented construction-management software system.

During this budget cycle System staff will continue its study of automated procurement systems, expand system-wide risk-management support and review available debt-management software options.

The Fiscal Year 2014 budget reduces System staff by two positions compared to Fiscal Year 2013. System administration will continue to monitor demand levels for current and new services and recommend appropriate staffing levels. Toward the end of Fiscal Year 2014 we will begin biennial preparations for the 2015 session of the Texas Legislature.

Fiscal Year 2014 salaries and total expenditures are budgeted 4.7% and 1.1% higher, respectively, compared to Fiscal Year 2013.

The System office financial condition is sound. It continues to operate at a staffing level and cost significantly below that of all other public university systems in Texas. I recommend your support of this budget request.

Annual Operating Budgets Required. It is expressly provided that the governing board of each of the institutions of higher education named herein shall approve on or before September 1, 2013 and 2014, an itemized budget covering the operation of the ensuing fiscal year, which budget shall be prepared within the limits of the revenue available. Each institution's operating budget shall contain a section(s) which provides budget amounts and the method of finance for each listed informational item of appropriated funds contained in this Act. A copy of each budget and any subsequent amendments thereto, shall be filed with the Legislative Reference Library and the institution's general library to be available for public inspection. Copies of each budget shall also be filed with the Legislative Budget Board, the Governor, and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board by December 1 of each fiscal year. (State of Texas, 83rd Legislature, General Appropriations Act, Article III Sec. 6.1 – Special Provisions relating only to State agencies of higher education.)
