BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Upon the approval of the Board of Trustees that the Chancellor be authorized:

- (1) To execute or authorize all contracts for personnel services, benefits, consulting, and professional services for which funds are appropriated and approved in the budget of the Central Texas College District for Fiscal Year Ending 2013.
- (2) To execute contracts for, or authorize through established policies of the Board of Trustees, the acquisition of goods, materials, supplies, equipment, and other items for which funds are appropriated and approved in the budget of the Central Texas College District for the Fiscal Year Ending 2013.

Chancellor's Budget Message

I am pleased to offer this budget for Board of Trustee review and approval consideration. The budget is balanced—a difficult task for a period forecasted to be one of dwindling state support, larger expenditures imposed by external support and contracted agencies, higher internal costs to adequately compensate our employees, deferred maintenance, and implementation of measures to assure quality and succeed in our mission while addressing increased complexity and compliance demands from accreditation, state, and federal agencies.

State officials have not determined the level of state funding for the next fiscal year as I submit this budget for your consideration, but we anticipate, and have planned for, additional cuts in support. However, this uncertainty makes financial planning extremely difficult, as you can imagine. We will continue to monitor funding discussions, report notable results to you, and adjust our budget accordingly.

The Department of Defense (DoD) contracting offices continue to squeeze our ability to provide worldwide education services to military members and their families, an important part of our mission not funded by local tax revenues. In the current calendar year DoD requested that we lower the agreed contracted tuition rate in the Pacific/Asia region, and we complied. Likewise, services on continental sites continue to be challenged. For example, instructional facilities for military members and their families were usually provided cost-free to the colleges operating on military installations. As a DoD cost-saving measure, we were asked to move our operations off-post in places. In other locations, we were asked to pay fees for installation access as well as increase our contributions to post education centers by providing computer labs, test centers, and even construct buildings on military installations.

Here at home, our in-district tuition rate continues to be among the lowest in Texas. We intend to maintain this advantage for our district residents. Nonetheless, the tuition rate for this budget includes an increase from \$59 to \$63 per credit hour based upon a schedule approved by the Board of Trustees several years ago. This year is the last year of preapproved, pre-designated tuition increases. Unlike other colleges, our students pay no across-the-board fees—this practice continues in this budget cycle.

We continue to strive to provide competitive compensation and benefits to attract and retain highly qualified personnel. The administration recommends and has included a one-step salary increase of 2.5% for full-time, regular employees not subject to separate contract or labor law. For those employees working under a DoD contract, we included the contracted salary scale.

As in recent years, we continue to address requirements identified in our master facilities plan. In this budget we included funding to complete a new maintenance building and preliminary design work on a future one-stop student success center. We have included funding to rehab some classroom spaces and improve some of the exterior Central Campus spaces.

I am confident that with this budget we will be in a position to continue exceptional education program offerings for the people of our district, military members around the world, and meet the education and training needs of our communities.

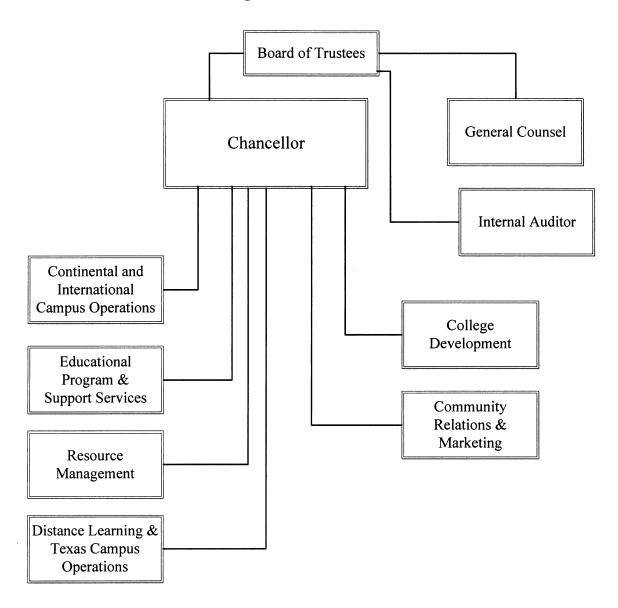

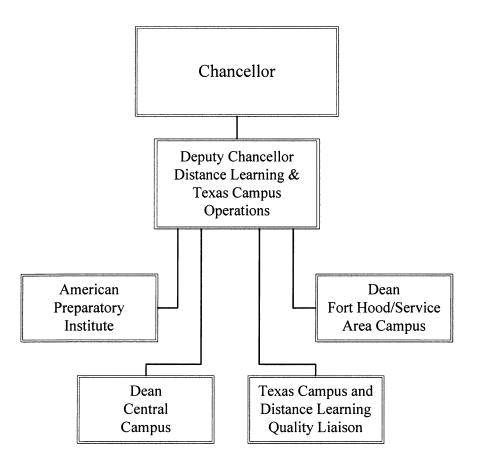

Organizational Structure

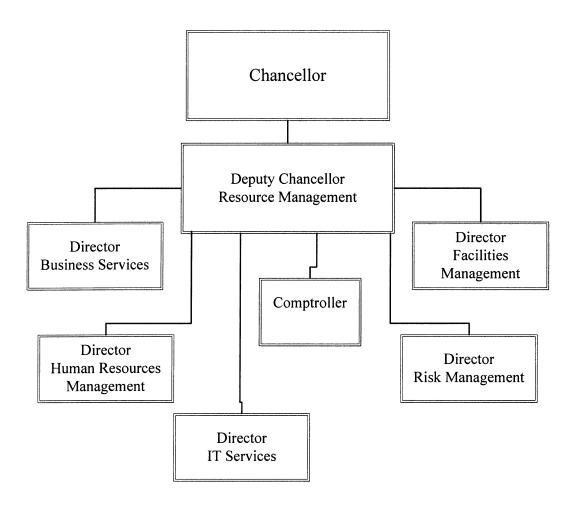


Deputy Chancellor Distance Learning and Texas Campus Operations

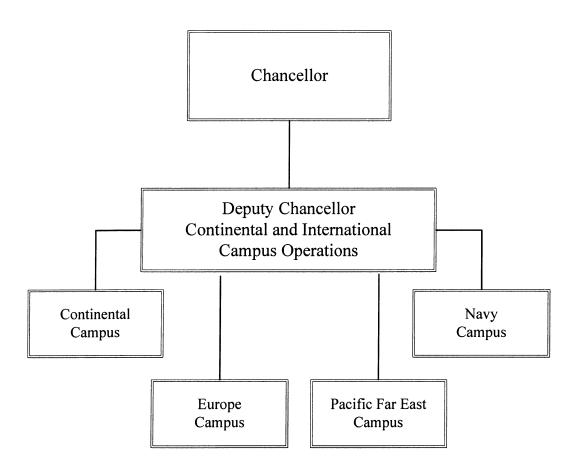
Organizational Structure



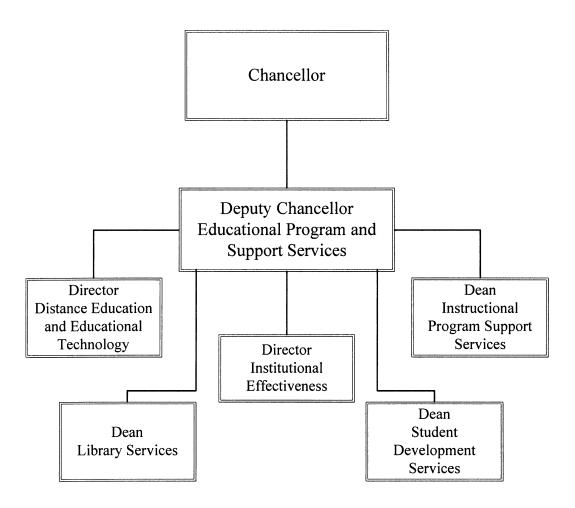
Deputy Chancellor Resource Management Organizational Structure

Tuition and Fees

CENTRAL CAMPUSES Tuition and Fee Schedule

TUITION AND FEES:

The State of Texas requires that each student sign an affidavit certifying his/her legal residence at the time of enrollment.

In order to be eligible for resident tuition rates, students must prove, to the satisfaction of the Admissions and Records Office, that he/she is entitled to be classified as a resident of Texas.

The responsibility of registering under the proper resident classification is that of the student, and questions concerning his/her right to classification as a resident of Texas must be clarified prior to the time of enrollment.

All tuition and fees are subject to change as approved by the Board of Trustees. All tuition and fees must be paid at the time of enrollment unless on the Deferred Payment Plan. A student is not officially registered until tuition payment is made in full. Until all financial obligations to the College have been satisfied, a student cannot register, graduate, or have a transcript issued.

A student who drops a course after the start of classes but then adds one of an equal cost will be allowed to do so without penalty if the drop/add occurred prior to the census date. If the charges for the hours dropped under such circumstances are greater than for the hours added, the refund schedule will be applied only to the net charges dropped.

1. TUITION - Semester Credit Courses

- Legal resident of the state of Texas: (In-District) \$63.00 per semester credit hour.
- Legal resident of the state of Texas: (Out-of-District) \$82.00 per semester credit hour.
- Legal resident of another state or a non-resident alien or students with excess undergraduate credit hours: \$185.00 per semester credit hour with a minimum of \$200.00 per semester.

2. OTHER FEES:

In addition to tuition, the following fees are required when applicable. Normally, fees are not refundable, however, a refund for overpayment of transcript/record fees will be made upon written application from the student. Exceptions require written approval of the Chancellor.

6. REFUNDS OF TUITION AND FEES

No tuition refunds will be made except in the case of cancellation or official withdrawal from Central Texas College or from a course. All refunds for tuition will be computed from the date the Application for Withdrawal or Refund is filed with the Records Office (not from the date of last attendance).

- Students who officially withdraw from the Institution shall have their tuition and mandatory fees refunded according to the following schedule:
 - A 100 percent refund is to be made for courses dropped prior to the first class day.
 - During the fall or spring semester or comparable semester:
 - during the first fifteen class days, 70 percent
 - during the sixteenth through twentieth class days, 25 percent
 - after the twentieth class day, none; and
 - Six-week summer semester:
 - during the first five class days, 70 percent
 - during the sixth and seventh class days, 25 percent
 - after the seventh class day, none
- For flex entry and non-semester-length courses with a census date other than the 12th class day (4th class day for a six-week summer semester)
 - -Prior to the first class day, 100 percent
 - -After classes begin, see table

- Class day count begins with the first day of instruction (the first calendar day of the term) and includes all weekdays, Monday through Friday, which are not designated official Central Texas College holidays.
- Tuition and fees paid directly to the Institution by Veterans Administration, Title IV (Financial Aid Programs), a sponsor, donor, or scholarship shall be refunded to the source rather than directly to the student.

- Special consideration is available under the following conditions:
 - Any student suffering a catastrophic illness/accident or death in the immediate family, and,
 - Active duty military students who receive PCS or deployment orders and dependent family members of active duty military, who receive PCS orders after the start of classes which require the service member to depart before the class is completed. A student must present a copy of deployment orders, medical certification, obituary, or death certificate along with the refund request to be eligible for special consideration. Refunds under these conditions will follow the tuition refund schedule listed below:
 - If withdrawing prior to the 20th class day for semester-length courses (or prior to the last day for 25 percent refund for non-semester length courses), 100 percent refund;
 - If withdrawing between the 21st day for semester-length courses (or the day after the 25 percent refund period for non-semester-length courses) and the mid-point of the course, 50 percent refund;
 - After the midpoint of the course, no refund will be given.

Please note that NTC rotations and field exercises are NOT considered deployments under this policy.
