Only one of the counties, Navarro County, provides ad valorem taxes to the college district. In Ellis County, the estimated population is 153,000. Projections convey that by the year 2020, Ellis County will have well over 210,000 people. Ellis County has grown at a rate of 36% since 2000, while the remaining four (4) counties report growth the maintenance and operations of three (3) off-campus centers outside Navarro County. rates between 1% and 10%. Meeting the educational needs of a diverse and changing service area population is a continuing challenge without tax revenues to support Navarro College serves a large rural area in North Central Texas. The service area is comprised of five counties: Navarro, Ellis, Limestone, Freestone and Leon Counties.

providing access to these Texas residents contributes to the quality of life in their communities. centers so residents in this part of the service area are able to access an institution of higher learning within a reasonable driving distance. The Board of Trustees believes Navarro College is a low wealth district. 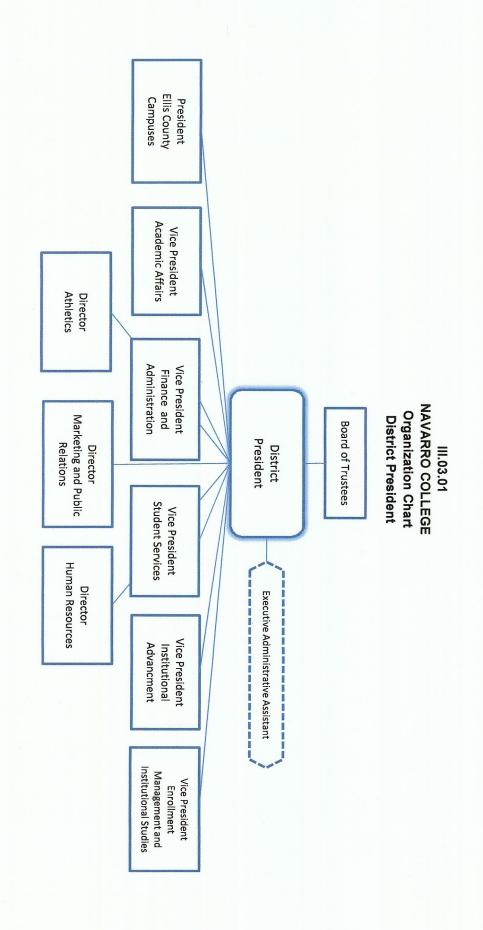
