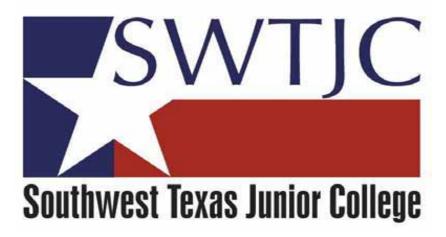

AGENCY MISSION

Southwest Texas Junior College is a comprehensive, public, two-year college serving eleven counties in southwest Texas. College programs and services provide accessible, affordable, high-quality post-secondary education that prepares students to: 1)enter the job market, 2) transfer to senior colleges and universities, 3) pursue their professional and personal goals. Through its programs and services, the college equitably provides higher education opportunities and supports the economic growth of the community.

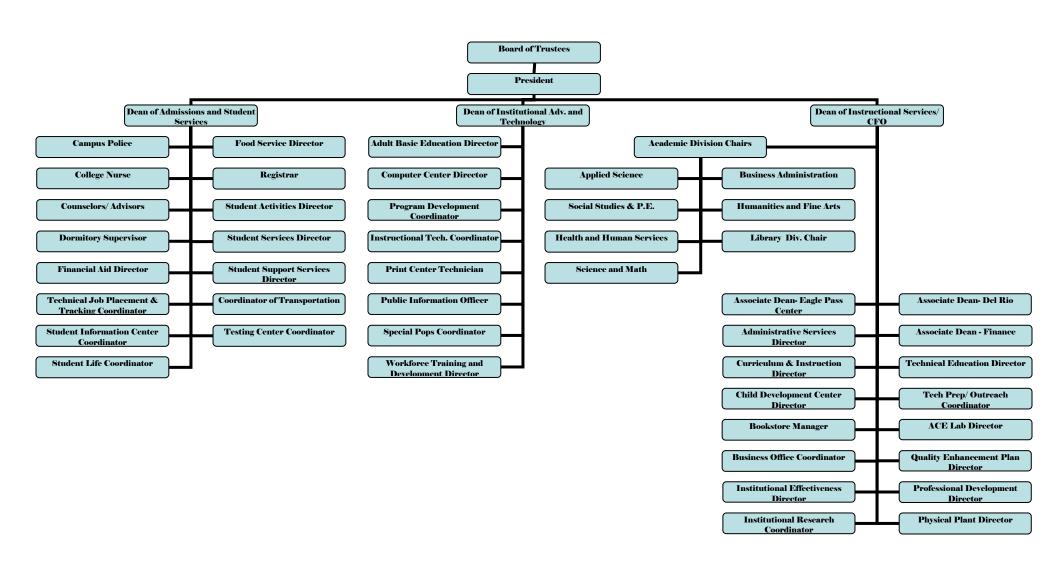
Southwest Texas Junior College (SWTJC) is a two-year college located in the extreme southwest corner of Texas and serves a vast region encompassing eleven counties (Dimmit, Edwards, Frio, Kinney, La Salle, Maverick, Medina, Real, Uvalde, Val Verde, and Zavala) – the largest geographical service territory in the state. SWTJC is an open-door college providing quality associate degree and certificate programs with campuses located in Uvalde, Crystal City, Pearsall, and the border cities of Del Rio and Eagle Pass. For sixty-one years SWTJC has provided high quality post-secondary education and training opportunities for the residents of Southwest Texas. SWTJC is the only community college in the area and is the only state community college that provides post-secondary educational opportunities to a region this large.

Over 98% of the region's population is clustered in and around twenty-one townships which comprise less than 5% of the available land, leaving vast areas virtually devoid of human habitation. According to 2006 U.S. Census Bureau figures, 75% of residents in the target area are Hispanic and 32.8% of all families in the area meet low-income federal guidelines. Of individuals age 25 and over, only 27.6% have completed high school and only 8% have completed college.

Since 2001, SWTJC has received diminishing state support as a percentage of total funds - a decrease of 5.5%. As a rural college, SWTJC has a low tax base where each \$0.01 in tax rate generates only \$140,000 in revenue – the current rate is \$0.11 per \$100 valuation. Of the 50 community colleges in the state, SWTJC ranks 43rd in tax generated revenue. Additionally, there are only three counties in the SWTJC taxing district but our service region includes 11 counties.

As SWTJC continues to provide accessible and affordable post-secondary educational opportunities throughout our rural service area, we strongly endorse the additional formula request that was made on July 31, 2008, by the Texas Association of Community Colleges.
