Temple College is experiencing a severe operating dilemma because of the State allocation reductions of the base funding formula recommended by the Texas Association of Community Colleges. Tuition and student fees have increased dramatically and program reductions have been implemented to reduce costs. Property taxes have increased during this period; however, a larger portion of that funding source, that is intended to fund facility renewal, is now being applied to operation costs. State allocations are currently at the same amount per student as in the FY 1993-94 cycle. This trend is forcing public institutions to be unavailable to a growing segment of the population which is contrary to the mission of the community college system.
