Our tax rate is 11.60 cents per \$100 valuation. The first \$5,000 or 1 percent of appraised value, whichever is greater, of owned and occupied residential property is exempt. Also exempt: the first \$75,000 of residential property owned and occupied by a person over 65 years old. Taxes assessed for persons 65 years and older or disabled are frozen for all future years in the amount paid in the year the tax payer first becomes eligible.

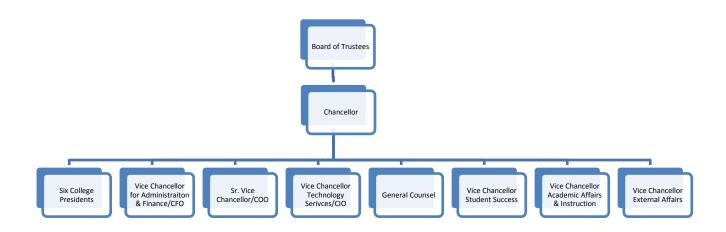
- Core Operations
