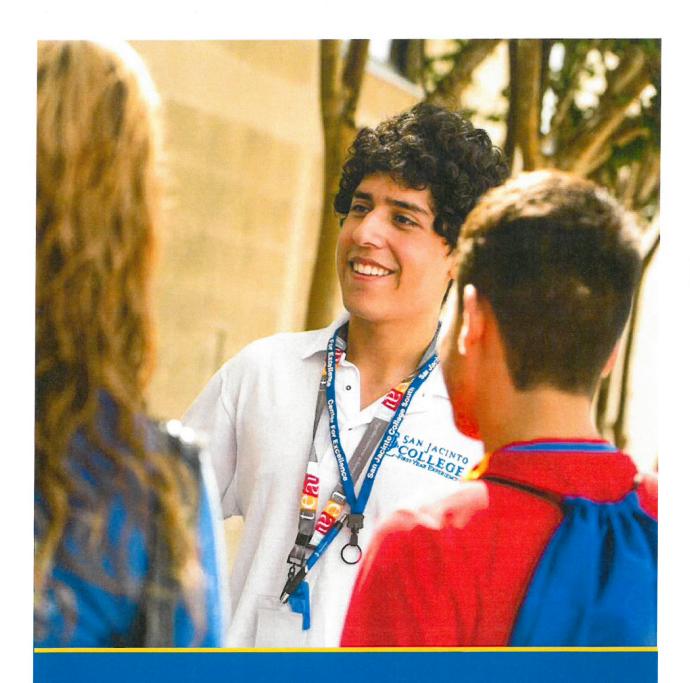

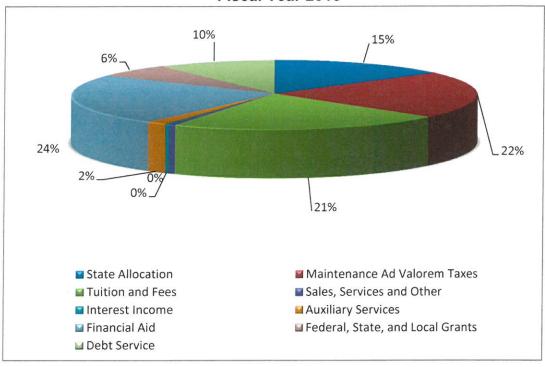

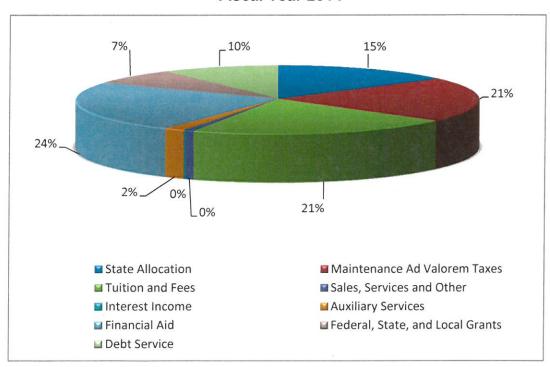

Fiscal Year 2015



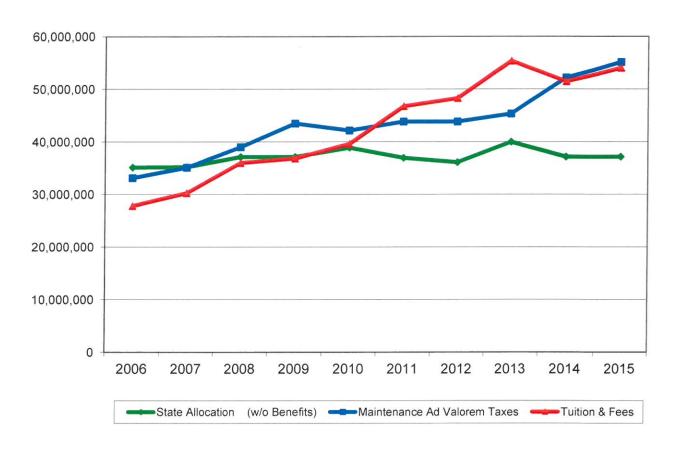
