EXECUTIVE REVIEW

The following documents provide summaries of the Texarkana College's 2015-2016 budget. The schedules detail projected revenue of \$43,751,417 for 2015-2016 when all funds are considered. This includes local tax revenue, state and federal funds and other sources, such as our auxiliary funds. Local M&O tax revenue is projected to be \$5,795,300 and State Funding revenue, including benefit funding, is projected to be \$8,543,513.

The following significant estimates or projections are integral to the preparation of this budget:

- ◆ Enrollment remains constant from the 2014-2015 school year to the 2015-2016 school year.
- ◆ Total PELL and Student Loan revenues and expenditures are estimated at \$14,900,000.
- ◆ Tax revenue is based upon certified values provided to the college by Bowie Central Appraisal District in July of 2015. Tax Revenue is based on the proposed rate of \$.113047 an increase of \$.00778 over the current year rate of \$.105267. The final tax rate will be voted upon at the September board meeting.

Using the projected revenue of \$43,751,417 which includes the Perot donation, and estimated expenditures of \$43,238,909 for all funds, we are projecting a budget surplus of \$512,508 for the year ending August 31, 2016. The board goal is to have a balanced budget without being dependent upon the Perot donation. We are still short of this goal at this draft of the budget, but will be working to bring the budget as close to breakeven as possible without the Perot funds throughout the year.

This budget was prepared based on information available as of August 22, 2015, and will be continuously monitored and presented back to the board for amendments as needed.

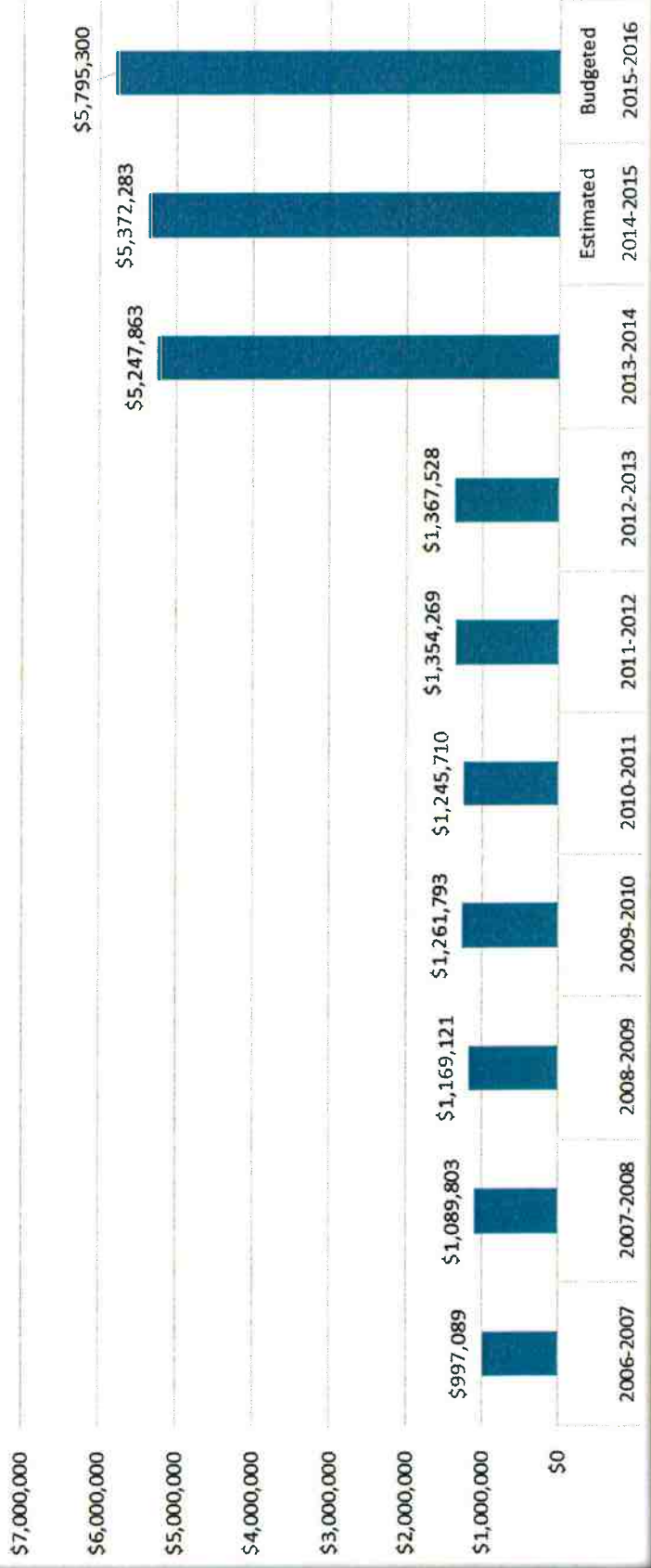

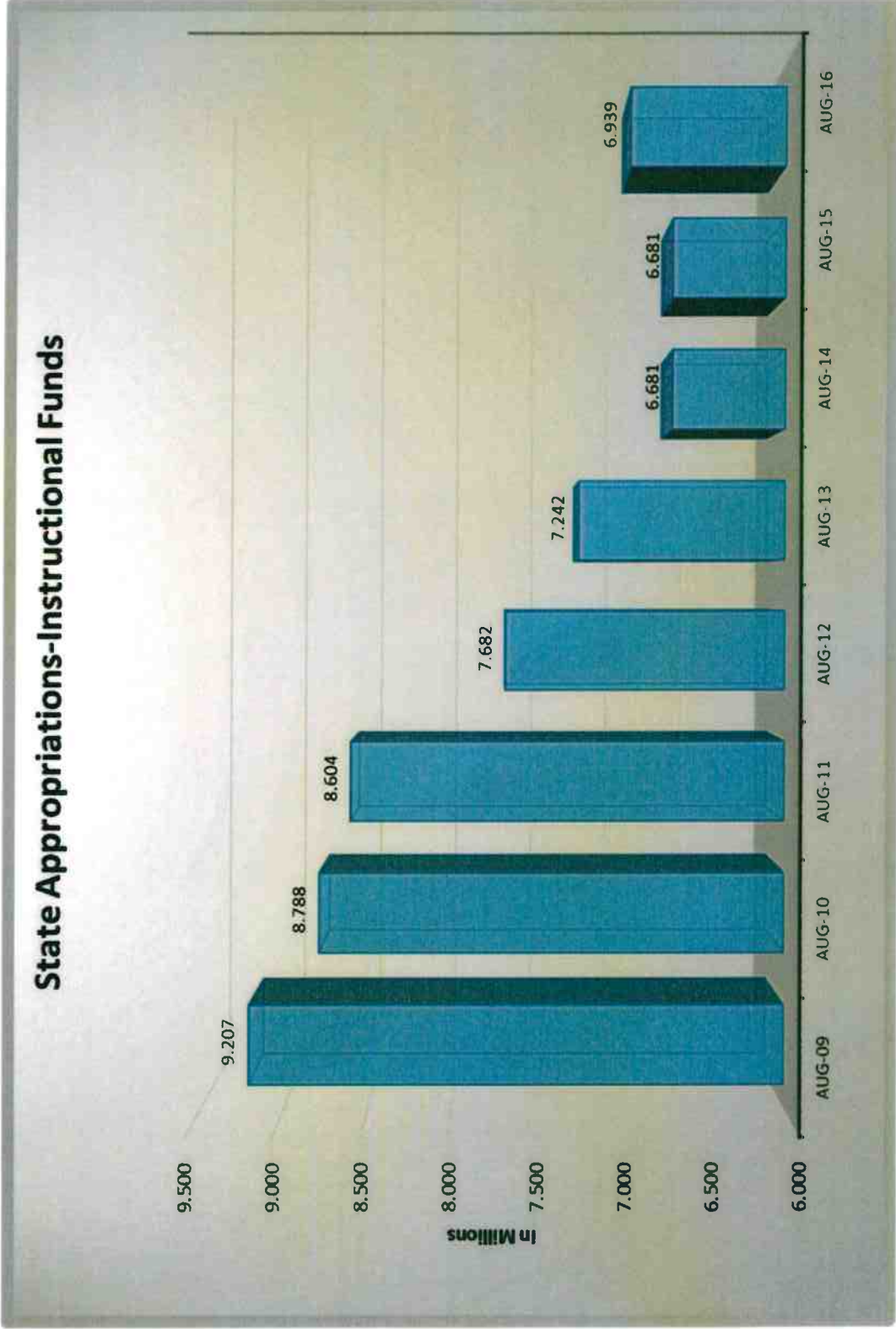

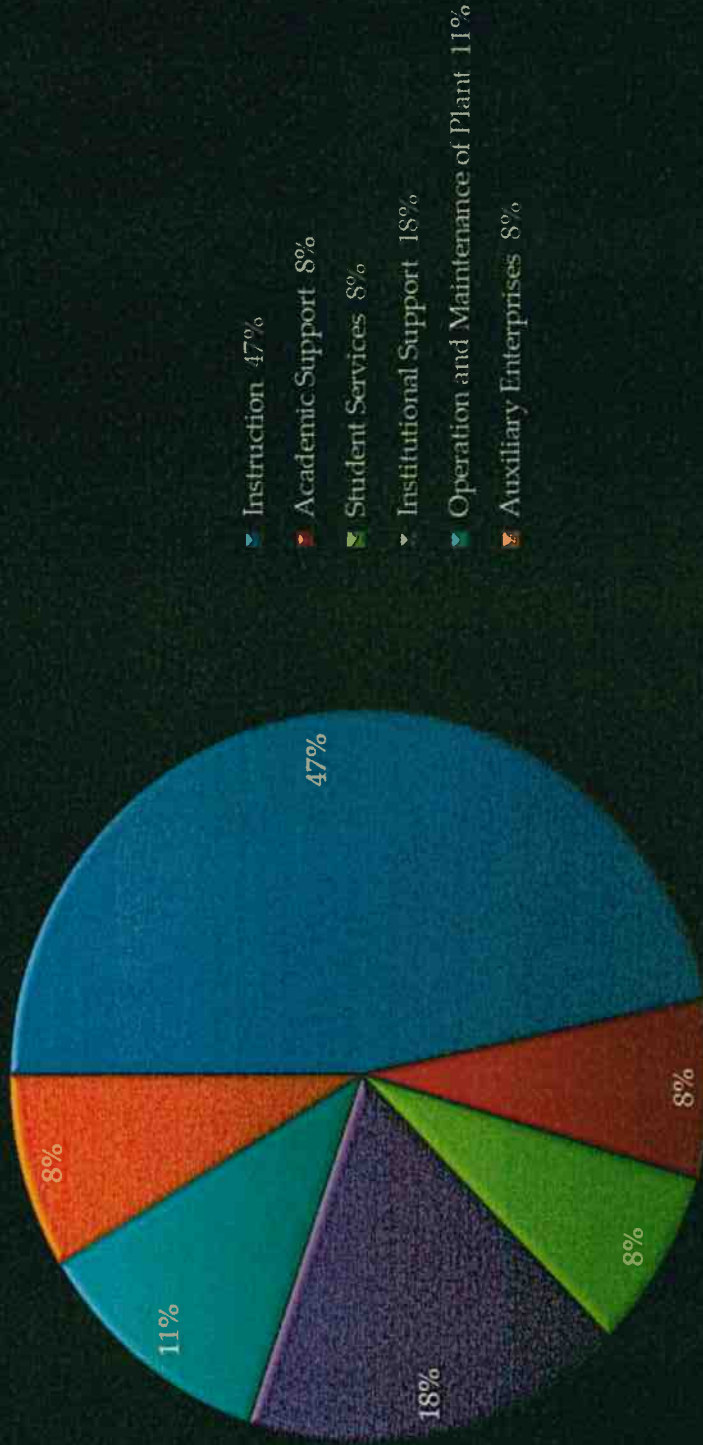
**Revenues by Source
(excluding Grants & Perot Donation)**



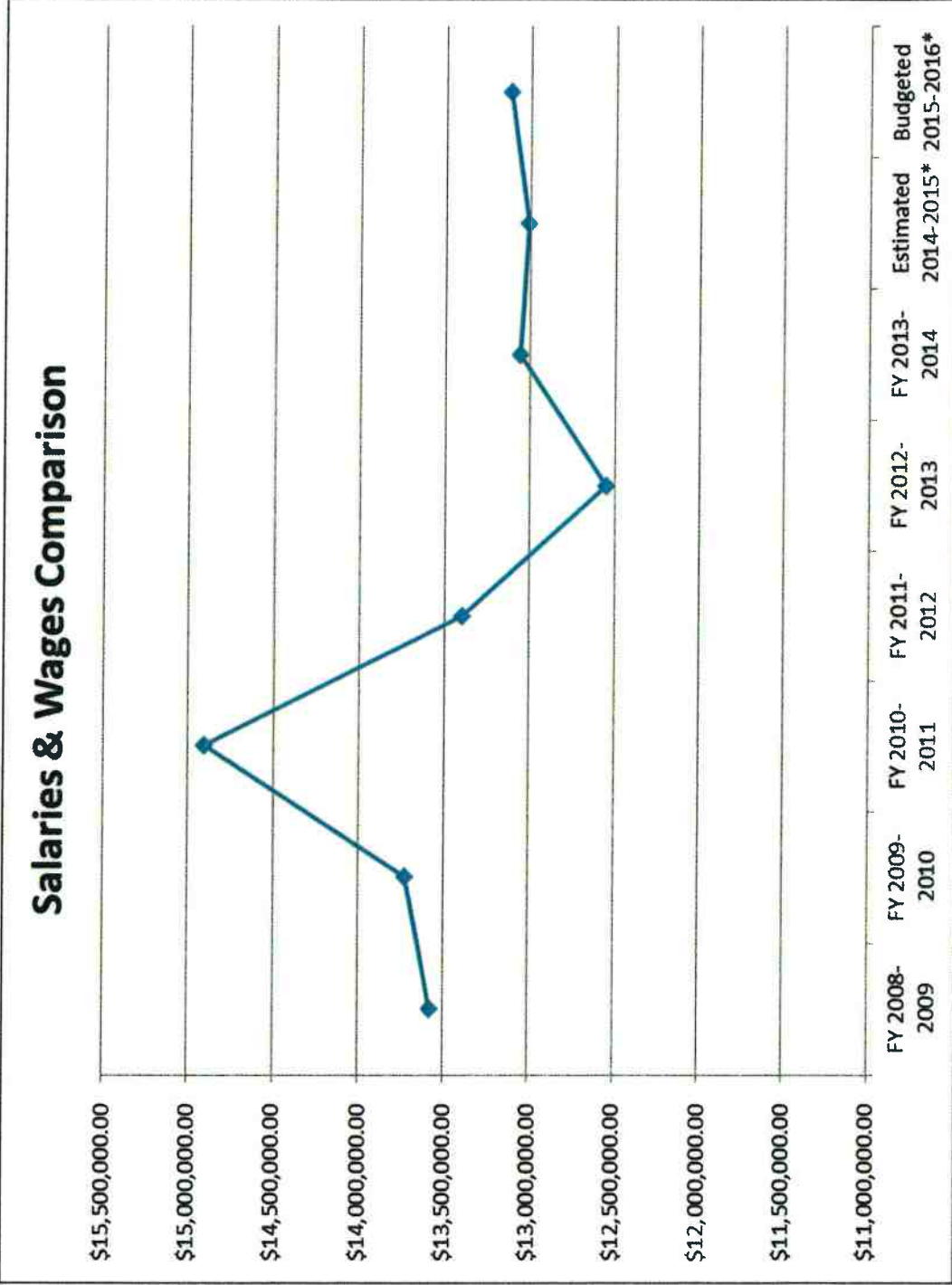

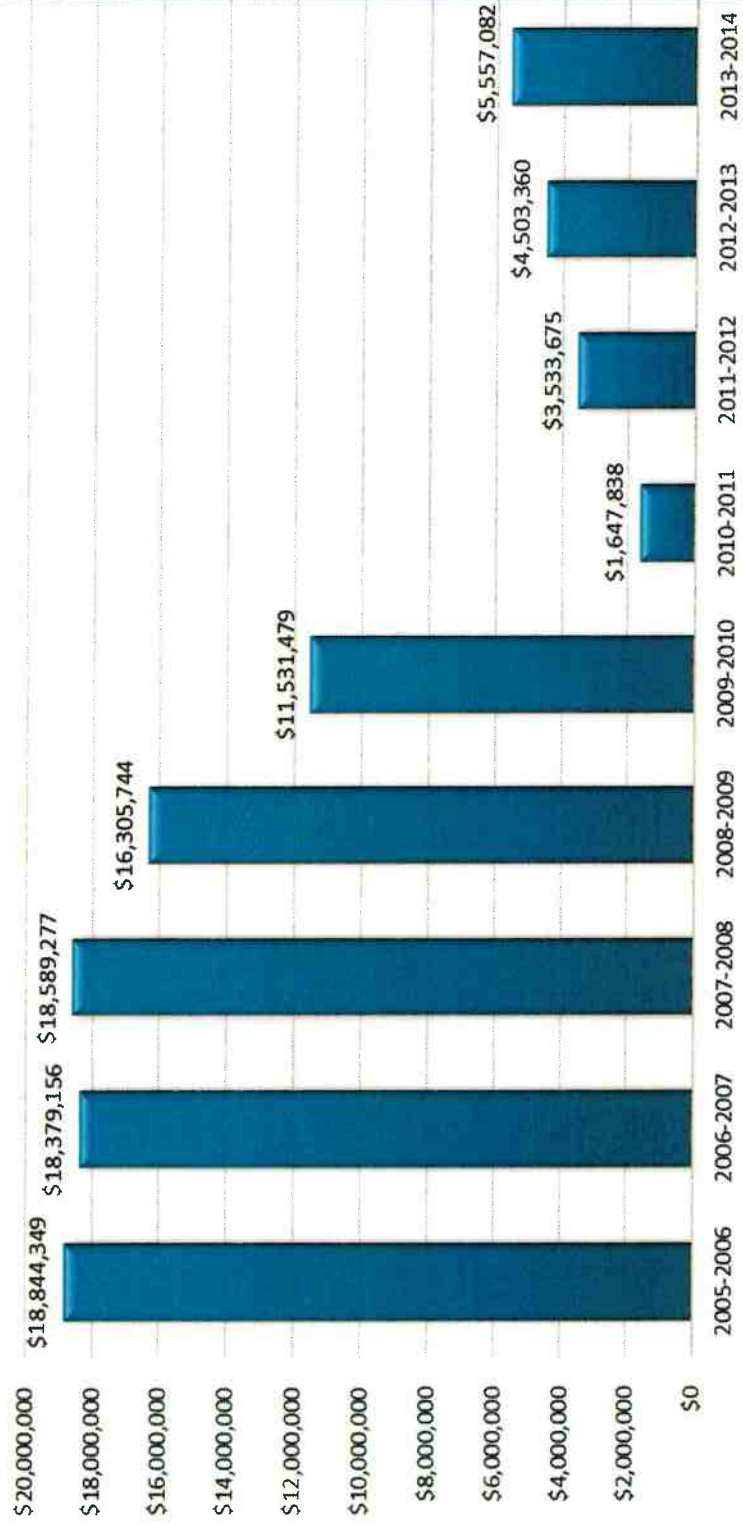
**Expenses by Function
