

Southwest Texas Junior College supports the \$1.8 billion formula funding request that was outlined in the letter for the Texas Association of Community Colleges on July 27, 2016. With additional support from the State of Texas, Southwest Texas Junior College will make the following investments:

- 1. Expand dual credit opportunities
- 2. Enhance student advising, at risk counseling, career planning, and placement
- 3. Expand technical programs offerings (welding, computer information systems, emergency medical technicians, and construction trades)
- 4. Upgrade campus safety and security

Southwest Texas Junior College is focused on providing services to students to help the state meet the goals set forth in the 60x30TX higher education strategic plan. The College is investing in a growing number of public school districts with dual credit and Early College High School programs to allow students to get college experience and credit while in high school. Also, SWTJC is participating in the first cohort of the Texas Math Pathways Project; allowing the College to embrace transformational strategies and practice. The College is actively working with university partners to improve student transfers by developing degree pathways. For example, our freshman students can declare their baccalaureate degree and major at Sul Ross Rio Grande College when they first register with SWTJC. Southwest Texas Junior College has advanced the employment opportunities in the region by financing successful technical degrees such as wildlife management and welding.
