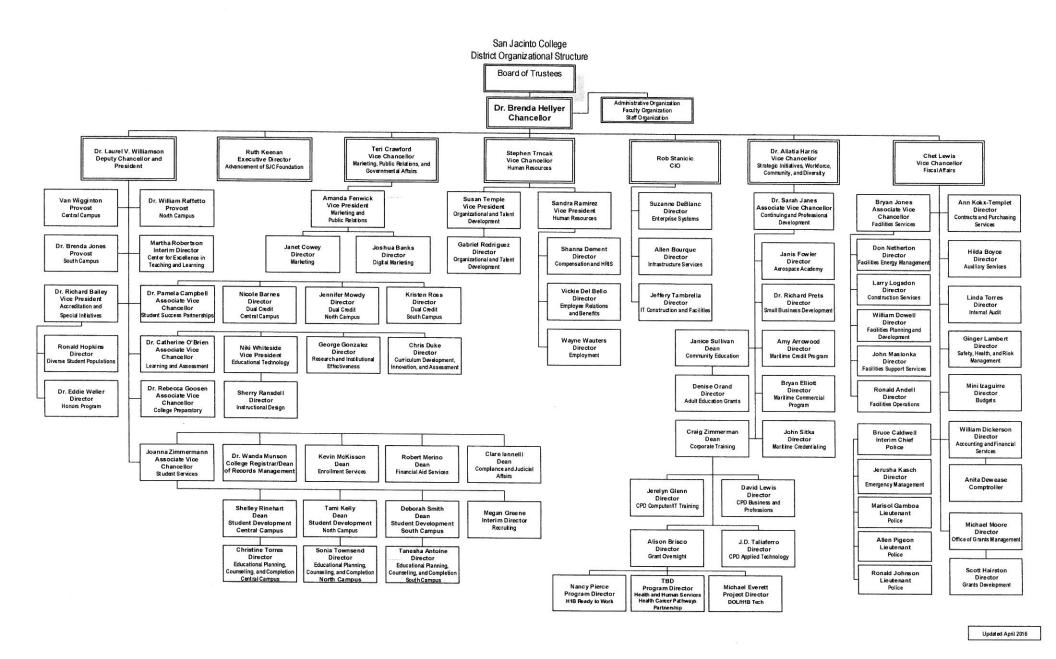

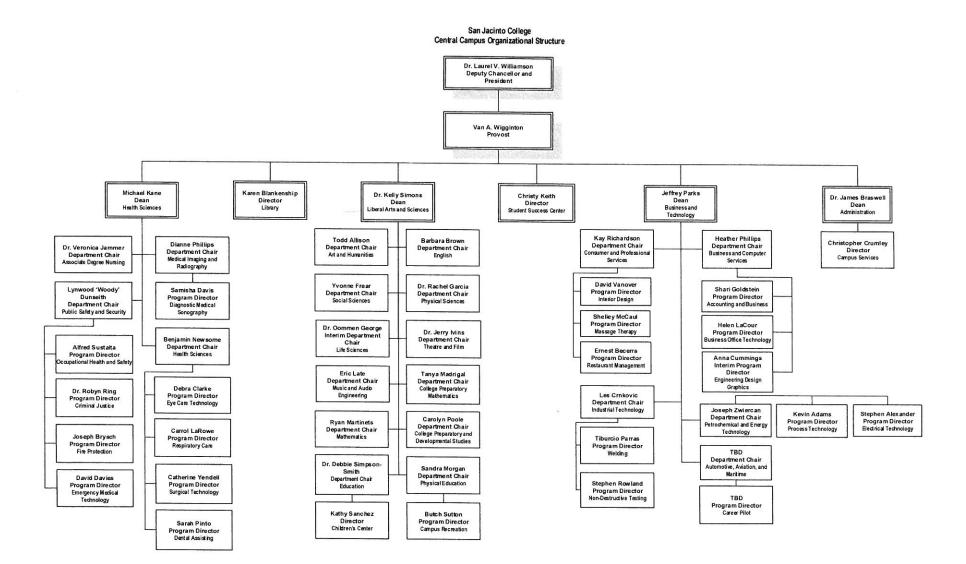

With additional support from the State of Texas, San Jacinto College will make the following investments to meet the goals of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board's 60x30TX strategic plan:

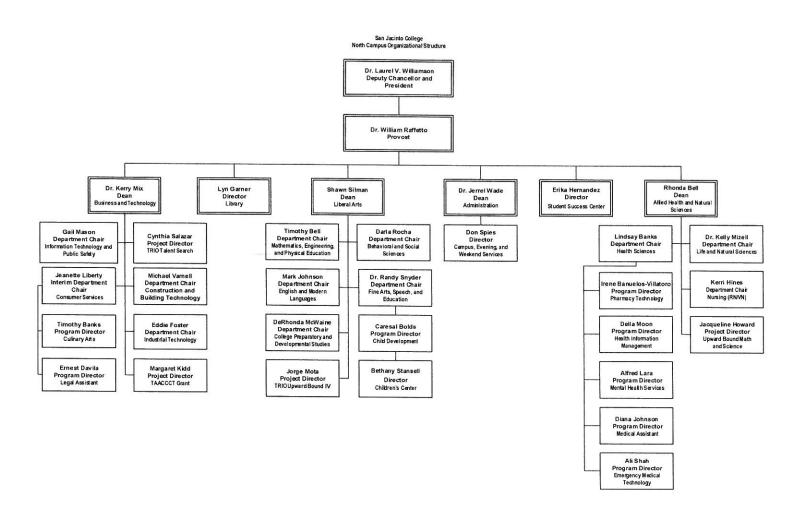
- o Expansion of advising and high-touch practices to support students.
- o Scale-up of Pathways transformative alignment work throughout the college system.
- o Expansion of dual credit and early college high school programs.
- Development of open source course materials, which will reduce the cost to students for textbooks and related course materials.
- Expansion of services to the community through Adult Basic Education and English as a second language programs.
- Complete grant project on distributing financial aid like a paycheck and bring this practice to scale to improve completion and reduce student debt.
- o Bring to scale programs that are improving student success such as:
- Several programs to help students through developmental and college level acceleration in math.
- Several programs to help students through developmental and college level acceleration in reading and writing.
- Intentional Connections program for our highest at-risk students including a case management model.
- o Mentoring and support programs for minority and first generation college students.
- o Upgrades for campus safety and security.

San Jacinto College is an institution that has been focused on increasing student completion while maintaining academic rigor and excellence in every area. The College is seeing consistent increases in completion rates for students through the programs that have been implemented. The College has repurposed funds to develop these programs, but additional financial support is needed to bring successful programs to scale system-wide with the intent that even greater increases will be accomplished. Through the Pathways work, San Jacinto College is moving towards a complete transformation to be an even more student-centered college that promotes completion of student educational goals through well-defined pathways and customer-service focused support. These efforts are fully aligned with the goals of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board's 60x30TX Strategic Plan.

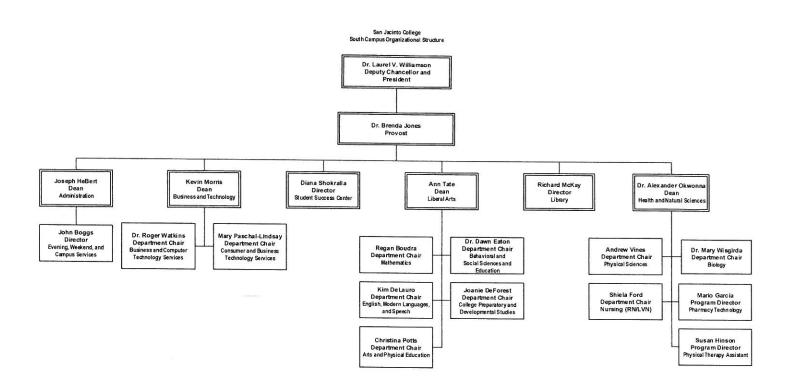
